The Central San Pedro Neighborhood Council endorses the proposal to resume 7 day a week full Service between downtown Los Angeles and San Pedro.

Bringing MTA's Silver Line south of the Harbor Gateway transit center will provide a one-seat ride between Union Station downtown and the Harbor Area. It will eliminate inconvenient waits for a connecting bus between the Harbor Area and the Silver Line at its present southern terminus in Harbor Gateway.

The community has been underserved except for a few peak hour weekday runs since the High Occupancy Toll lanes (HOT Lanes) started four years ago; that is when Harbor Area transit riders lost through San Pedro - Los Angeles service.

There will be a public hearing the evening of September 16th, 2015 at the Grand Annex in downtown San Pedro on this proposal.
