- Welcome and Introductions (5 minutes)
 - Meeting chaired by HGN. Present: Harbor Gateway North-Rosalie Preston. Harbor Gateway South-Miguel A. Cordova and Katy Carlson. Harbor City-Grant Reed, Steven Rutherford and Greg Donnan. NW San Pedro-Diana Nave. Central San Pedro-Allyson Vought and Carrie Scoville. Coastal San Pedro-June Smith and Bob Gelfand. DONE-Gracie Liu and Joe Hari. LAUSD-Fred Quintana. Bureau of Sanitation-Daniel Hackney.
- Scavenging of recyclables - Daniel Hackney, Bureau of Sanitation (15 minutes)
 - Scavenging costs the city money and is illegal. However, LAPD does not enforce the law because it would cost more to arrest and prosecute than the amount of money they lose from the scavenging. Bureau of Sanitation is looking into the possibility of issuing tickets to scavengers who are homeless and “mom and pop” scavengers. They want to enforce the law on those who are running large scale scavenging operations.
- LAUSD Budget Update – Freddie Quintana (10 minutes)
 - Fred Quintana presented LAUSD’s revised budget for 2012-2013. Budget is also available on LAUSD’s website.
- Health & Wellness Element Feedback (10 minutes)
 - Members of HANC voiced their collective displeasure at the lack of preparation and failure to facilitate an open-ended discussion regarding the Health and Wellness Element of the General Plan. It was agreed upon by those present that Miguel A. Cordova would write a letter expressing HANC’s displeasure.

- President's meeting with CD 15 report (5 minutes)
 - With the exception of Watts NC all the members of HANC were at the President's meeting. President's meeting was held at Los Angeles Harbor College and catered by the culinary arts program.
- DONE Update (10 minutes)
 - Mayors budget came out last week. Most departments were asked to take a 10% cut with the exception of DONE because they cannot afford to take more cuts. Elections will come out of NC budgets. NC's need to do strategic planning to ensure that they are able to fund elections. Two positions at DONE were deleted but two were added.
- BONC Update (10 minutes): NC Plan Review & Reform Committee – Diana Nave/Allyson Vought
 - Change in stakeholder definition is going to BONC. NC's can write to Janet Lindo to express their positions.
- Consolidation of Planning Department and Building and Safety Department (5 minutes)
 - City Council is considering consolidation of the Planning Department and Building and Safety Department. Merge is meant to streamline the process.

 - PCAC meeting is tomorrow. The Harbor Commission will vote whether or not to keep the P.C.A.C
