Forms Assistants help students and families filling out both FAFSA and CA Dream Act forms and answer general questions regarding the form if needed. Forms assistant volunteers will need to attend a FAFSA or CA Dream Act training prior to the event.

General Volunteer

General Volunteers perform miscellaneous duties at Cash for College Workshop Sites, such as, registration, administrative tasks, or other on-site needs. No training required.
