The White Point Nature Center in San Pedro is a unique and environmentally valuable part of our community. Any impact that the reconstruction of Paseo del Mar could have on the nature center should be examined thoroughly.

The Central San Pedro Neighborhood Council in support of the Coastal San Pedro Neighborhood Council urges the Department of Public Works to extend the public comment period on the Initial Study – prepared in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) for the Paseo del Mar Permanent Restoration Project – to 90 days from when the study was released.

The Central San Pedro Neighborhood Council is opposed to Alternative 4 detailed in the study, rerouting the roadway through the White Point Nature Preserve. That option has serious shortcomings and was rejected by City representatives during previous deliberations on Paseo del Mar reconstruction. The Council urges you to remove that option.

We look forward to a response from your office in regards to our concerns.
