

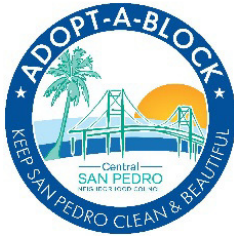

The Group/Individual will designate a leader who will recruit, register, and brief participants prior to any event. Volunteers under the age of 12 must have adult supervision.</p> <p>Participants are providing volunteer services to the Group/Individual and not to the Central San Pedro Neighborhood Council, Clean San Pedro or the City of Los Angeles. Group leaders are responsible for the safety of volunteers.</p> <p>Central San Pedro Neighborhood Council will be responsible for the install of one Adopt-A-Block sign identifying the Group/Individual along the adopted area and provide cleanup bags and gloves as needed. The Group/Individual is responsible for arranging the removal of collected trash if needed. ## ADOPT-A-BLOCK APPLICATION

The Adopt-A-Block program is sponsored by the Central San Pedro Neighborhood Council and therefore only blocks adopted within the boundaries of Central San Pedro are eligible to be adopted. For a map of area, go to [www.centralsanpedro.org](http://www.centralsanpedro.org)

The locations below have been identified by Clean San Pedro, a San Pedro non-profit organization based in San Pedro. Groups/Individuals are not restricted to these blocks however, these area will receive priority consideration by the selection committee.

This is a pilot program for the 2018-19 year. The pilot phase includes a maximum of 10 locations. The selection reserves the right to limit the number of locations for each Group/Individual.

- 1) Gaffey Street (between 6th and 7th)
- 2) 12th Street (between Gaffey and Cabrillo)
- 3) 13th Street (between Gaffey and Cabrillo)
- 4) 2nd Street (between Pacific and Mesa)
- 5) Grand Ave (between 6th and 7th)
- 6) Grand Ave (between 7th and 8th)
- 7) Grand Ave (between 8th and 9th)
- 8) Grand Ave (between 9th and 10th)
- 9) 8th Street (between Gaffey and Pacific)
- 10) Ofarrell (between Grand and Pacific)
