

Homelessness Committee Report:

In collaboration with the Los Angeles County Homeless Initiative, the Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority (LAHSA) is seeking your input on how we should use local Measure H tax dollars and additional State funding to combat homelessness.

LAHSA will be hosting eight community listening sessions across each of Los Angeles County's Service Planning Areas (SPA) to seek your input. These sessions will be an opportunity to weigh in on what strategies are working well and should be expanded, what major gaps exist, and how services and programs should be designed to most effectively address homelessness.

Whether you are a service provider, a person with lived experience of homelessness, a local government official, or a concerned neighbor, these sessions are open to all members of the public. For those that are unable to attend the sessions, an online form on the LAHSA main webpage will be available for partners to give feedback starting on Friday, November 8. We hope you will join us—your voice and expertise are critical ingredients in ensuring that Los Angeles' homeless system is effective and equitable.
