Community Impact Statement Support of Alternative Housing and Shelter Options

Council File 20-0147-S33

The following motion was approved at the June 16, 2020 Stakeholder Meeting of the Central San Pedro Neighborhood Council:

The Central San Pedro Neighborhood Council supports the city's desire to acquire and site tiny homes, trailers, container homes, or other alternative housing and shelter options to ensure that persons experiencing homelessness will have shelter or housing. We have read the report dated May 5, 2020, from the Chief Legislative Analyst and City Administrative Officer and are hopeful that in addition to the City Recreation Centers, Project Roomkey, and RV Safe Parking programs, the city will explore the use of container homes and acquiring large vacant megastores, as well as using vacant Port of LA property for Safe Parking Programs, for the purpose of housing and servicing our community members experiencing homelessness. We implore the City Council to work swiftly on this matter.
