

Neighborhood Councils/Chamber Presidents/Port Meeting: August 24, 2020

1. Legislative Update: Federal
Climate Smart Ports Act (\$1 billion; zero emissions; CD 15 support); Harbor Maintenance Tax; Corona Virus relief;
State:
Funding for clean energy and related infrastructure; transportation infrastructure; Port Workforce Training Center;
2. Environment
Continued commitment; complying with mitigation efforts;
Using shore power: 74% of vessels;
2019 Emission Inventory: carbon monoxide increase; greenhouse gases and nox decrease;
CARB truck ruling: clean trucks by 2035;
CARB At-Berth Regulation: need funding support; oppose regulation for tankers;
3. Town Square/Promenade (Berths 74-84)
Completion by July 2021;
Area B (south of Fish Market): 30 foot promenade;
Area C (Maritime Museum to Fish Market): round about under construction; parking lot; public restrooms; transit dock (800 ft.);
4. Port Community Grants
LAMI (Top Sail)-6th year; Wilmington Boys and Girls Club—2nd year;
5. POLA Updates
 - A. PAIP: delays due to pandemic; revised financial estimates; prioritizing of benefits on hold; cost increases due
To construction delays and connectivity of projects; use of union labor; project work: “low bid” that is responsive to specifications;
 - B. Delays: outer harbor cruise terminal, Warehouse 1, Boat Yard, Cabrillo Marina Way;
 - C. China Shipping (Berths 97-105): SEIR passed by BOHC and approved by City Council;
