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Resolution Re: Request to consider Lots E & F for Emergency Use

The following Resolution was passed by the Central San Pedro Neighborhood Council Board at its January 19, 2021 meeting.

Whereas Lots E + F are located on the north side of 22nd Street between Miner and Sampson Way in the Port of L.A. It is approximately 4 acres of unused open space and will be unused for some time especially during two more years of construction at Ports O' Call.

Whereas San Pedro immediately needs a safe and clean space away from the sidewalks for the homeless encampments. There are no portable toilets for the homeless that live along Beacon street between 7th Street and Crescent Ave, Gulch Street, Palos Verdes Street, 8th Street, 9th Street, and Pacific Ave between 19th- 17th Streets.

Therefore Be It Resolved that the Central San Pedro Neighborhood Council (CeSPNC) urgently requests, in the spirit of "we're all in this together," the Port to allow the EMERGENCY TEMPORARY USE of lots E + F for the homeless that camp along our streets in San Pedro. The CeSPNC further requests that the Port and/or the City provide portable toilets, 2 or more as needed, and 6 trash cans, with toilets to be pumped and trash cans to be emptied on a weekly basis, and that LAPD and the Port Police work in tandem to ensure that these homeless encampments will no longer be allowed on San Pedro's streets and parkways because of this new location at Lots E + F.

CeSPNC shall file a Community Impact Statement.
