Frequently Asked Questions

Why do we do the Count?

To get the official statistics of what homelessness looks like in our community. These are then used to bring needed services and housing to the South Bay.

How often is it conducted?

Every year in January, with the exception of 2020 when it was cancelled due to the pandemic.

How will I know what to do that night?

You will be fully trained and provided with the materials you'll need. First timers are welcomed!

How old do I have to be?

All volunteers need to be at least 18 years old to participate in this activity.

How It Works

- **We will be following COVID protocols to ensure everyone's safety.**
- This year we invite you to sign up in teams of 3 or 4. Singles are also welcomed and can form a team at the event.
- After checking in at the site, your team will drive the roads in your assigned census tract.
- You will just be tallying how many people you see – keeping a respectful distance from them – using the new smartphone-based app.
- You will be asked to view a short training video prior to the event and download the app
- When your team finishes, you return to the deployment site to upload final numbers, return supplies and check out. This is when you will receive a Certificate of Participation.
- After registering, keep a look out for email updates from the Greater Los Angeles Homeless Count for reminders and other news about the event.
