The Central San Pedro Neighborhood Council (CeSPNC) requests that the Port of Los Angeles provide a complete written report of all relevant information with respect to the listing of the Phillips 66 Oil Terminal, Berths 148-151 on the POLA Toxic Site list. The report should include a history of remediation efforts performed at the site, and a history of the property's legal liabilities.

Additionally, the CeSPNC requests that there be a comprehensive clean-up of the entire terminal site with public reports issued on the progress of the clean-up effort. Further, the CeSPNC asks the Port to consider requiring a clean -up of all Port sites when there is a change of leaseholders.
