On October 18, the CeSPNC voted to support the motion in Council File No. 22-0943 regarding pursuit of funding alternatives to fully staff the seven City-owned animal shelters, with the elimination of the exploration of parcel taxes to achieve the goals of the motion. The Board additionally requests that the City augment budgeted General Funds to enforce the existing Spay Neuter Ordinance and eliminate barriers for volunteering to provide higher welfare for the animals at City Animal Shelters.
