WHEREAS, CIS 22-0943 was forwarded to the Los Angeles City Council Finance Committee on August 16, 2022; and

WHEREAS, CIS 22-0943 specifically requests the Los Angeles Department of Animal Services (DAS) be provided adequate funding, via increased budgetary allocation to fully staff, manage and operate all seven of its animal shelters; and

WHEREAS, CIS 22-0943 provides six different Courses of Action (COAs) to be considered by the Los Angeles City Council Finance Committee (A-F) as ways of increasing DAS' yearly budget to cover its operational needs;

BE IT RESOLVED, the Central San Pedro Neighborhood Council strongly supports CIS-22-0943 and believes that City run animal shelters are critical to in ensuring stray animals are provided safe and loving homes, while also providing critical care services that greatly boost the public welfare; and

BE IT ALSO RESOLVED, the Central San Pedro Neighborhood Council strongly supports COA-A which directs the City to provide DAS additional General Fund expenditures, as necessary for DAS to achieve its stated goal of achieving full staffing and expanded shelter operational hours.
