

**Central San Pedro Neighborhood Council
Vice Chair's Notes from Port Committee
Meeting of March 23, 2023**

1. Connectivity Plan
Michael Cham reported that the community workshop has attracted 70-80 people and was videotaped. The Plan is in the draft and development stage, and will be presented to the BOHC sometime this coming summer. Future public meetings, including neighborhood councils, are planned.
2. Cruise Ship Terminal RFP
The RFP has been released. There will be opportunities for public comment.
3. Los Angeles Waterfront Update
A draft NOP was released for Berths 148-151 at the Philipps 66 Refinery. This initial study came about after many negative comments about the original "mitigated negative declaration."
4. CAAP (Clean Air Action Program)
The POLA and POLB will hold an update on March 8. Information can be accessed at clearairactionplan.org.
5. Front Street
The Front Street Beautification groundbreaking was held on March 9. Port Committee Chair James P. Allen was in attendance.
6. POLA/Chamber Mixer
An event was held on March 9 to celebrate women who have made notable contributions to our community.
7. The POLA STEM (Science-technology-economics-math) event was held on March 11.
8. L.A. Fleet Week will be held on the Memorial Day weekend.
9. Earth Day at the Port will be held on April 11, 11-2 pm.
10. Port Police Updates
 - A. They helped in the Fish Market moving process.
 - B. They participated in the Knoll Hill Dog Park clean-up.
 - C. "Coffee with a Cop" will be held on a Wednesday at Sirens.
 - D. They will be glad to visit neighborhood councils.
 - E. Much of their enforcement work is conducted in Wilmington, engaging truckers who are in violation of weight loads on restricted streets, parking restrictions, and who travel through residential neighborhoods not

designated for truck traffic.

11. Port Updates

A. West Harbor

- 1.) Construction activity will begin soon on Phases 1A and B.
- 2.) Soil remediation will be performed at the old San Pedro Fish Market site.
- 3.) The San Pedro Fish Market will have a pop up on the north side of the property
- 4.) CD 15 is working with the local agencies to find employment for Fish Market employees

B. Alta Sea

- 1.) Electric infrastructure and solar roofing are underway.
- 2.) Renovations of Berths 58-60 will begin in April.

C. Wilmington Waterfront

- 1.) There have been redesign issues connected with the riprap steps leading to the water.
- 2.) The project will to the BOHC sometime in March.
- 3.) The Grand Opening is scheduled for August 19 at Bannings Landing.

12. General Updates

- A. CD 15 will hold a Townhall in San Pedro on March 23 at Peck Park. The meeting will begin at 5:30 pm.
- B. According to the Chamber, there are many job openings in the hospitality area.
- C. The POLB held a public meeting on March 15 to solicit comments on Pier B, a portion of whose rail is in Wilmington.
