Re: Designation of Anderson Senior Center

WHEREAS; Anderson Memorial Senior Citizen Center was opened as a s Community and Senior Center in 1926 after the Death of Newell O. and Effie i. Anderson’s two sons during the Spanish Flu Pandemic

WHEREAS; On October 13, 1968, the City of Los Angeles re-dedicated Anderson Community and Senior Center as a Senior Center.

WHEREAS; The redesignation of the Anderson Community and Senior Center changed the administrative agency charged with oversight, management, and funding of the center.

WHEREAS; The Central San Pedro Neighborhood Council (CeSPNC) has worked with the City of Los Angeles and the Anderson Senior Center to build a playground and structure at Anderson Community Center.

WHEREAS; Anderson Senior Center should be open for families in the community beyond the newly installed playground.

BE IT RESOLVED, the Central San Pedro Neighborhood Council strongly recommends that the City of Los Angeles re-designate the Anderson Senior Center as a Community Center to meet the original intent of the space and serve the broader Central San Pedro Community.

**For the purposes of this document impact is measured, but not limited to, parking spots displaced, road and sidewalk closure hours, road obstruction hours, environmental impact of generators, vehicles, trucks, and other equipment operated for the benefit of production.*
