Specifically, we need the BHC to align with the globally-recognized, science-backed guidance from the United Nations Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change to **peak climate emissions before 2025** and **cut them in half by 2030** in order to remain on a 1.5 C (2.7 F) global warming trajectory that respects planetary boundaries and avoids climate catastrophe.
